If you are a teaching staff member from Erasmus+ KA131 partner university of Mykolas Romeris University - MRU (LT VILNIUS06), you are hereby invited to apply for an international Teaching Week taking place alongside the annual MRU Science and Innovation Week (MOin) – one of the University's flagship events dedicated to research, innovation and interdisciplinary collaboration.

International professors are invited to deliver lectures to MRU students in any academic field offered at the University while also taking part in the rich programme of MOin.

The 2026 edition of MOin will focus on MRU's Research Contribution to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Throughout the week, participants will have the opportunity to attend research presentations, panel discussions, networking events, exhibitions and project showcases bringing together researchers, academics and external partners.

Activities will take place across all MRU campuses in Vilnius, Kaunas and Marijampolė, providing an excellent opportunity to explore the University's academic community and establish new international collaborations.

The Teaching Week welcomes academics from disciplines in social sciences and humanities interested in sharing

their expertise with MRU students and expanding international cooperation. According to the topic of lectures, lecturer will be put into direct contact relevant academic coordinator and they will together finalize the times and final topics of teaching that will be put into a common programme of international teaching week.

– Mykolas Romeris University will provide practical guidelines to selected participants (including advises on accommodation, public transportation, etc.)

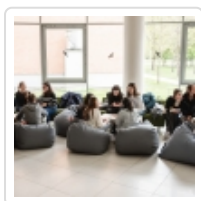

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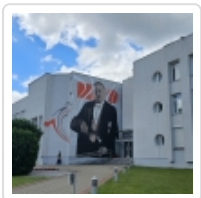
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
